REV. RAMON MARIA LUZA BAUTISTA, S.J.

Fr. Mon entered the Society of Jesus in 1977. He holds a Doctorate in Spirituality from the University of London, and has had many years of experience in formation in San Jose Seminary inside Ateneo de Manila campus, St. John Vianney Seminary in Cagayan de Oro City, as the Novice Master of the novices for over twelve years at the Sacred Heart Novitiate, and currently the Assistant Tertian Master for the international tertianship program of the Assistancy. He is also much sought here and abroad for his gift in giving talks on spirituality, spiritual direction, and retreat-giving. Fr. Mon has written several books on Ignatian Spirituality, Ignatian discernment, and prayer, including *Schooled by the Spirit* which received the Catholic Mass Media Award for Best Book in Spirituality.



MS. EVA GALVEY

Ms. Galvey had her training in the Art of Spiritual Direction at Burlingame, California, USA and at the Guelph Center of Spirituality in Ontario, Canada. She was trained in the Way of Accompaniment in the Ignatian Tradition in Rome. She is a Founding Associate of the Emmaus Center for Psycho-spiritual Formation and was its Executive Director in 1996-1999. She was also the Executive Director of the Center for Ignatian Spirituality from 2001-2005 and has been a member of the Board of Trustees of San Jose Seminary since 2012. She is currently involved in the training of spiritual/retreat directors at Emmaus, conducts psycho-spiritual formation to formators, diocesan priests and seminarians and parish-school development leaders. She designs, develops, conducts prayer workshop modules, courses for spiritual directors and Ignatian retreat givers. She has extensive experience in group facilitating with various clientele and training group facilitators. She teaches Ignatian Spirituality at the Ateneo de Manila University.



REV. FINBAR MAXWELL, M.S.S.C. is Irish by nationality.

He was ordained as a Columban in 1988. He holds Master's degrees in Psychology and Pastoral Counseling, and a Doctorate in Transpersonal Psychology, with an additional doctoral specialization in Spiritual Direction, and both Masters and Doctoral specializations in Creative Expression (the use of the expressive arts for psychological and spiritual insight and integration). He worked in Lahore, Pakistan for 20 years where he ministered to the economically poor city Christian community parish. He also taught courses to men and women in formation. He led retreats and workshops for many years, and had a counselling and spiritual direction practice in Lahore. Fr. Maxwell has been in the Philippines since May 2013, where he is presently working in the Columban formation house, in Quezon City.
